

Please help the Disabled Children to build a house

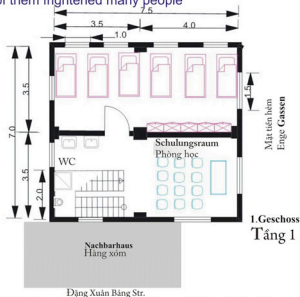


The small house in the province of Nam Dinh has 50 square meters, it was an auto repair shop. Bishop Peter has bought the house for 7 disabled girl and refurbished - it was a stopgap measure for the girls.

The number of children has now risen to 17. Most of them come to us because their parents have died or they are no longer endure their isolation.

They come from different places to us.

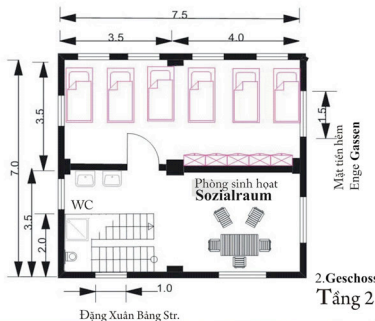
Initially, the children deserve nothing because none of them has an education. Their families can not care for them, with their physical disabilities, they are not able to do practical work, and nobody wants them. The sight of them frightened many people

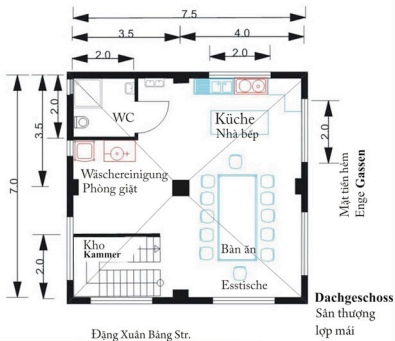

The training is quite difficult because the degree of disability varies.

Besides Photoshop, the children sell other different products like phone card, sim card, paper, soap ...

One of the girl goes now to Hanoi to learn Microsoft Office, so she can later re-Learn other children at home and take over other home-workers such as letter writing, calculations, fill out forms.....

It is very difficult to accommodate all 15 girls and 2 boys in a small house and some of them can not climb the stairs, while others need a slightly larger bathroom or other toilets.

The cooking space is too high because a girl is only 1.2 m large, another is bent. 2 girls have only one hand, one has no hands, the other a foot.

The small house is broken in the sense of the word. It stinks when the toilet is in use or something is fried. The children must keep their clothes in the plastic bag. In the toilet, kitchen and bathroom there is no ventilation, the water is in the toilet
